The last day of **Snow PACK** (Friday, February 24th), we will have a tubing hill party with hot chocolate and cookies.

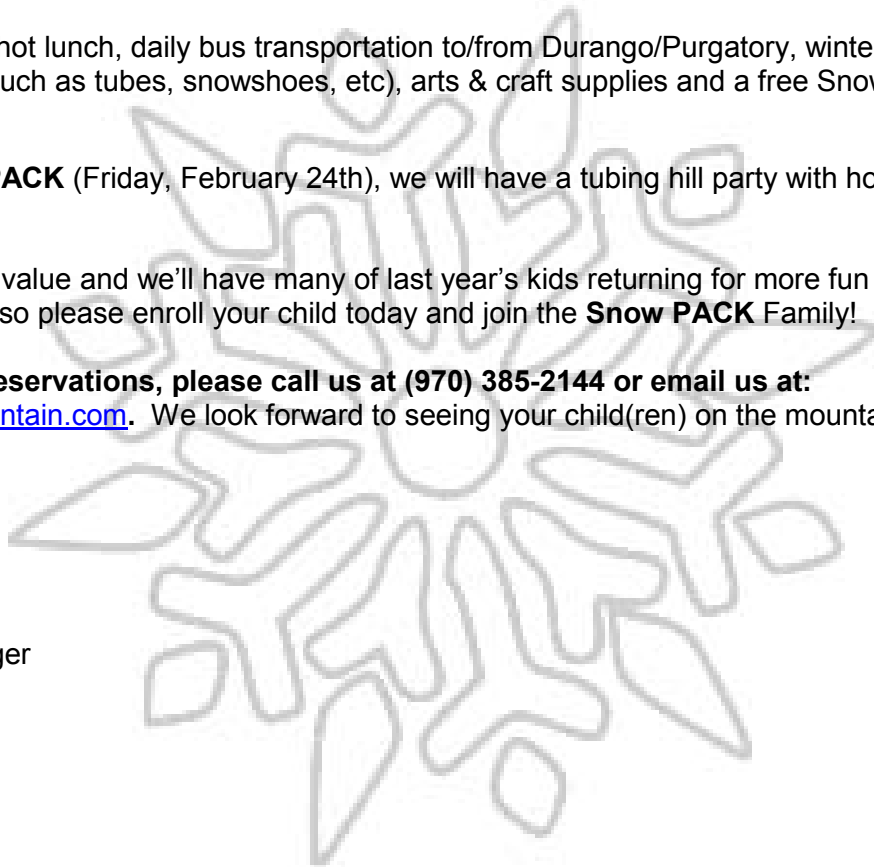
Snow PACK is a great value and we'll have many of last year's kids returning for more fun ... and space is limited ... so please enroll your child today and join the **Snow PACK** Family!

Snow PACK Information 2012

A Typical Day at Snow PACK

Buses leave town at 8:00 am and make several stops on the way to the resort (see schedule below for bus stops and times). After arriving at the resort, we divide into small groups and start our activities. We break for lunch around 12:00 pm. After lunch campers continue with the daily activity or head back to the base area to have fun. At 3:00 pm everyone gathers in the Base Area. Counselors make sure the children have gathered all of their personal belongings, and at 3:00 pm the bus departs from the resort and heads to town (see schedule on next page).

Snow PACK Activities:

AGE APPROPRIATE ACTIVITIES FOR SUCCESS IS OUR GOAL!

Nordic Skiing: Nordic skiing days offer a chance to have a great time exploring trails in the Purgatory area. Based on the weather forecast and the general energy level of the children, trails & destinations are chosen on a day-by-day basis. Before the activity starts, Team Leaders plan out which terrain to discover. After lunch campers play games and then head back to the Base Area. Some participants enjoy longer adventuresome fun in the snow while others enjoy a less active afternoon. In the event of adverse weather, our team gathers together for fun indoors.

Snowshoeing: It's a fun day at Snow PACK when we head out for a snowshoe outing. We will fit our shoe shoes, go over basic techniques and then hit the trail for winter adventure. We will look for winter wildlife and tracks along the way. Children will rotate between snowshoeing and winter craft projects.

Teamwork: Everybody wins during teamwork day. Counselors facilitate group tasks to achieve a common goal. Activities include: scavenger hunts, mysteries, the human knot, trust, snow fort building, orienteering and winter skills, and more.

Winter Skills: Map reading, winter preparedness, beacon knowledge, & introduction to winter survival skills are some of the activities we will be learning on winter skills day. Groups will rotate between activities which are mix of hands-on experiences, scavenger hut & games.

In the case of inclement weather we will move learning modules indoors, and continue with learning and fun until weather permits.

Be Prepared!

Your child needs to bring the following items:

- Lightweight warm under layers of clothing.
- Snow resistant outer coat.
- Snow pants or bibs.
- Eye Protection (sunglasses or goggles).
- Winter hat, gloves, & neck-gator.
- Snacks.
- Backpack for extra layers.
- Water Bottle (Hydrated Children are Happy Children!).
- Sunscreen please apply in morning, Team Leaders will assist with reapplication.
- Lip balm with SPF.

DMR CHILDREN'S SKI AND RIDE SCHOOL PROGRAMS WARNING, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY & INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING. THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY & WAIVER OF CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS.

1. The person who is participating in DMR Children's Ski and Ride School Programs, including Snow PACK programs shall be referred to hereinafter as "Student". The "Undersigned" means only the Student when the Student is age 18 or older OR it means both the Student and the Student's parent or legal guardian when the Student is under the age of 18. The Undersigned agree and understand that taking part in ski school, skiing, snowboarding and using ski area facilities, including the lifts, for any purpose (hereinafter the "Activity"), can be **HAZARDOUS AND INVOLVES THE RISK OF PHYSICAL INJURY AND/OR DEATH.**

2. The Undersigned are advised that a person using any of the facilities of the ski area is considered a skier. The Undersigned acknowledge and understand the dangers and risks of skiing and understand that the Student, as a "skier" under Colorado law, **ASSUMES ALL INHERENT DANGERS AND RISKS** as provided by the Colorado Ski Safety Act (hereinafter "Act").

3. The Undersigned further understand and agree that in signing this Agreement, the Undersigned are expressly **acknowledging and assuming additional risks and dangers that may result in property damage, physical injury and/or death above and beyond those outlined in the Act, including but not limited to:**

Falling; drills; exercises; free skiing; following the direction of the instructor; terrain selection of the instructor; avalanches; cornices; suffocation; crevasses; equipment failure; equipment malfunction; equipment damage; Student's improper use of equipment; Student's use of his/her own personal equipment; Student's failure to maintain or otherwise upkeep his/her own personal equipment; slick or uneven surfaces; slipping; tripping; loss of balance; rugged mountainous terrain; bumps; tree wells; downed timber; rocks of various sizes; holes; debris; marked and unmarked obstacles; drainage channels; varying visibility; unmaintained trails; path and/or trail obstructions; unmarked roads and/or trails; Student or another acting in a negligent manner that may cause and/or contribute to injury to Student or others, such as selecting terrain that exceeds his/her ability and not acting within such ability; Student's failure to comply with signage; collisions with natural or man-made objects or collisions with other people; falling objects; encounters with snowmobiles and/or other motor vehicles; becoming lost or separated; lack of shelter; lift loading, unloading, and riding; storms, lightning, hail, snow and other adverse weather; limited access to and/or delay of medical attention; Student's health condition; strenuous activity; fatigue; exhaustion; dehydration; hypothermia; high elevation; altitude sickness; frostbite; & mental distress from exposure to any of the above.

4. Pursuant to Colorado law, Student assumes the responsibility of maintaining control at all times while engaging in the Activity. Student is responsible for reading, understanding and complying with all signage, including instructions on use of lifts. Student must have the physical dexterity and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload the lifts. Student assumes the risks of riding the lifts and engaging in activities accessible from the lifts. Further, the Undersigned understand that a minor Student may use the ski lifts without an adult present. I agree and understand that DMR Childrens Ski and Ride School Programs are not licensed as a day care center nor do they comply with all the statutory requirements for a day care center. The Undersigned are advised that snowmobiles, snowmaking, and snow-grooming equipment may be encountered at any time, and the Undersigned recognize that falls and collisions occur and injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence of the Activity.

5. The Undersigned acknowledge and understand that the description of the risks listed above are not complete and that participating in the Activity, whether or not described, may be dangerous and may also include risks which are inherent and/or which cannot be reasonably avoided without changing the nature of the Activity. By signing this document, the Undersigned recognize that property loss, injury, serious injury and death are all possible while participating in the Activity. **RECOGNIZING THE RISKS AND DANGERS, THE UNDERSIGNED UNDERSTAND THE NATURE OF THE ACTIVITY AND VOLUNTARILY CHOOSE FOR STUDENT TO PARTICIPATE IN AND EXPRESSLY ASSUME ALL RISKS AND DANGERS OF THE ACTIVITY, WHETHER OR NOT DESCRIBED ABOVE, KNOWN OR UNKNOWN, INHERENT OR OTHERWISE.**

6. Additionally, in consideration for allowing the Student to participate in the Activity, **THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY AGREE NOT TO SUE** DSC/Purgatory, LLC, d/b/a Durango Mountain Resort or any of their respective successors in interest, affiliated organizations and companies, insurance carriers, agents, employees, representatives, assignees, officers, directors, and shareholders (each hereinafter a "Released Party") for any property damage (including but not limited to equipment damage), injury or loss to Student, including death, which Student may suffer, arising in whole or in part out of Student's participation in the Activity. By agreeing not to sue, the Undersigned **are releasing any right to make a claim or file a lawsuit against any Released Party**. Also, the **UNDERSIGNED AGREE TO HOLD HARMLESS AND RELEASE EACH AND EVERY RELEASED PARTY FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY** and/or claims for injury or death to persons or damage to property arising from Student's participation in the Activity, **including, but not limited to, those claims based on any Released Party's alleged or actual NEGLIGENCE or BREACH of any CONTRACT and/or express or implied WARRANTY**.

7. By execution of this Agreement, the Undersigned also **AGREE TO DEFEND AND INDEMNIFY/REIMBURSE** each Released Party from any and all claims of the Undersigned and/or a third party arising in whole or in part from Student's participation in the Activity.

8. In consideration for allowing Student to participate in the Activity, the Undersigned **AGREE THAT ANY AND ALL CLAIMS** for injury and/or death arising from the Student's participation in the Activity shall be **GOVERNED BY COLORADO LAW** and **EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION** of any claim shall be the **DISTRICT COURT OF LA PLATA COUNTY, COLORADO** or in the **FEDERAL COURT FOR THE STATE OF COLORADO**.

9. In the case of a minor Student, the Undersigned parent or legal guardian acknowledges that he/she is not only signing this Agreement on his/her behalf, but that he/she is also signing on behalf of the minor and that the minor shall be bound by all the terms of this Agreement. Additionally, by signing this Agreement as the parent or legal guardian of a minor Student, the parent or legal guardian understands that he/she is also waiving certain rights on behalf of the minor that the minor otherwise may have. The undersigned parent or legal guardian agrees that but for the foregoing, the minor Student would not be permitted to participate in the Activity.

10. The undersigned further authorizes anyone working with the DMR Childrens Ski and Ride School Programs to call for such medical care for the child or to transport the child to the appropriate clinic or hospital if, in the opinion of anyone working with DMR Childrens Ski and Ride School Programs, medical attention is needed for the child. The undersigned agrees that upon turning the child over to the undersigned or their designees or to the ambulance or other medical transport, medical facility, clinic or hospital, that the responsibility of DMR shall be totally fulfilled and DMR shall not have any further responsibility for the child. The undersigned agrees to pay all costs associated with such medical care and related transportation of the child and indemnify and hold DMR, its representatives, agents, affiliates, directors, servants, and employees harmless from any costs incurred therein, or any claims arising therefrom. The undersigned hereby authorizes any medical facility or medical provider to provide care for the child if it is believed that the child requires medical attention.

11. The undersigned gives full permission for DMR to use any audio or visual materials of said minor(s) taken during the DMR Childrens Ski and Ride School Programs and by signing below, I am releasing the use of any audio or visual materials taken, or on file, and for any uses by DMR of me or my child(ren). I understand that all said images and sound recordings shall constitute the property of DMR, solely and completely.

12. By signing this Agreement without a parent or legal guardian's signature, Student, under penalty of fraud, represents that he/she is at least 18 years of age. If signing as the parent or guardian of a minor Student, signing adults represent that they are a **legal** parent or guardian of the minor Student.

13. The Undersigned understand and acknowledge that this Agreement is a contract and shall be binding to the fullest extent permitted by law. If any part of this Agreement is deemed to be unenforceable, the remaining terms shall be an enforceable contract between the parties. It is the Undersigned's intent that this Agreement shall be binding upon the assignees, subrogors, distributors, heirs, next of kin, executors and personal representatives of the Undersigned.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THE FOREGOING ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY & INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT AND UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. I AM AWARE THAT I AM RELEASING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS THAT OTHERWISE MAY EXIST.
